

...BEGINS TODAY WITH PALM SUNDAY

A day on which we celebrate the Lord's entry into Jerusalem. Palms will be blessed at all Masses. The 11am Mass will begin in the Hall with the Blessing of the Palms, followed by a **Procession to the Church** with a Solemn Reading of the **Passion according to St Matthew**. In the afternoon there will be: **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** from 4pm-5pm concluding with **Evening Prayer of the Church** at 4:45pm.

Holy Week Masses:

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, Mass will be at 6:45am and 9am as usual. Please note, there will be no 9am Mass on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Saturday NOR 6:00pm Mass on Holy Saturday.

Maundy Thursday:

Mass at 5pm for young families and the elderly who cannot come to the Celebration at 8pm: Mass of the Lord's Supper begins at 8pm, includes the washing of feet and concludes with watching and praying until 11:30pm at the Altar of Repose. Please try and spend some time watching. 11:15pm Night Prayer of the Church (Compline).

Good Friday:

Is a Day of **Fasting and Abstinence**.
