

From September 2025 St John Fisher will be offering a three term intake to any child who is eligible.

Child turns 3 between:	Child can start Nursery:
1st September - 31st December	January 2026
1st January - 31st March 2026	April 2026
1st April - 31st August 2026	September 2027

### Rising 3s

Children who turn 3yrs old during term time, and who are eligible, can take up a funded Early Education place <u>the Monday after</u> their 3rd birthday.
