


The Year of Prayer 2024 and the Jubilee Year 2025:

The Holy Father has decided that 2025 will be a year of Jubilee. The theme is a 'Pilgrimage of Hope'. In preparation for the Jubilee Year, 2024 has been designated a 'Year of Prayer' and particular focus on the Our Father. This presents us with a great opportunity to go back to the basics of prayer.

There will be two Masses on Ash Wednesday, at 9am and 7.30pm. From Monday 19th February there will be two daily Masses during Lent on Monday to Friday, at 6.45am and at 9am.

The Holv Season of Lent:

This year the Lenten Season begins on Wednesday 14th February. Lent is a time of self-renewal as we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. The 3 important pillars of the Lenten Season are: Fasting, Prayer, and Almsgiving. Prayer offers us a very special opportunity to grow in our relationship with God and to deepen our commitment to a way of life, rooted in our baptism. In our busy world, Prayer provides us with an opportunity to reflect upon our patterns and sins. Fasting and almsgiving are intended to help us to subdue our desires. During Lent God does not need the chocolate, sweets, and other trivial things we give up. He needs us to look deep within ourselves and reflect. He wants our hearts. So, our fasting will be beneficial if it helps us to stop our obsession with the self and start thinking about what truly matters in life. We pray that this Lenten Season will be a journey of faith that will lead us to a more intimate relationship with God and with each other.


