**Friends of LIFE - Baby Loss Awareness:**

Throughout October we have a Baby Loss Memorial in Church to commemorate the lives of those lost before, during, or shortly after birth for any reason. The memorial space includes prayer cards, as well as details of support services for anyone who needs them.

**Missio - Second Collection next weekend:**

Missio is the Church's official organ for the support of foreign missions. The collection taken on World Mission Sunday goes in its entirety to support Churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor. Missio works through local bishops. Churches and missionary congregations to ensure that resources are distributed equitably and justly on the basis of need. The money goes directly from England and Wales to the bishops in the mission territories: local church directly helping local church.

### **Safeguarding:**

The Archdiocese of Southwark is committed to the safety and welfare of children and vulnerable adults. ### **Laudate Deum:**

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, released an Apostolic Exhortation, *Laudate Deum*. It is in effect an update to his encyclical *Laudato Si*, given the very limited progress achieved over the years since *Laudato Si*. Pope Francis finished *Laudate Deum* by explaining why he chose that title: "Praise God is the title of this letter.
