

Bishop Howard Tripp sadly passed away on Monday 3rd October. We remember with gratitude all the work he did in our Parish, first as the Area Bishop of the Southwest Pastoral Area, and then after his retirement when he was residing at St. Catherine's Close. We have opened a book of condolences for him, and a special prayer is said for the happy repose of his soul at each Mass. The details of his funeral will be communicated soon. May his soul rest in peace.

Missio - Second Collection - Next weekend:

Missio is the Church's official organ for the support of foreign missions. The collection taken on World Mission Sunday goes in its entirety to support Churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor. Missio works through local bishops. Churches and missionary congregations to ensure that resources and distributed equitably and justly on the basis of need. The money goes directly from England and Wales to the bishops in the mission territories: local church directly helping local church.
