



We have now received the details regarding the funeral of Bishop Howard Tripp at St. George's Cathedral Southwark.

- Wednesday 2nd November 18.00
 Reception of the Body followed by Mass of All Souls' Day.
- Thursday 3rd November 12.30. Solemn Requiem Mass, followed by internment in the Cathedral Vault.

Missio - Second Collection - This weekend:

Missio is the Church's official organ for the support of foreign missions. The collection taken on World Mission Sunday goes in its entirety to support Churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor.

All Saints' Day - Tuesday 1st November:

Is a holyday of Obligation. All able bodied Catholics are expected to attend Mass unless any serious reason, sickness or distance prevents. There will be Mass on Monday 31st October at 6pm and on Tuesday 1st November at 9am and 7:30pm.

There will be two Masses to mark All Souls Day. During the 7:30pm Mass, the names of all who have died in this parish since All Souls Day 2021 will be read out and a candle lit for each.
