Peace Service: We would like to hold a Peace Service on 1st January. There would be no singing, or refreshments, but hopefully we could play some hymns. There is a CD player at the Church, or music can be played from an iPad if someone has a speaker. Julie will ask Father Matthias if we can plan this.

Any Other Business: Stamps: Teresa took some stamps to Jesuit Missions, we will continue to collect these and advertise it nearer Christmas.

Meetings: As Sandra and Mike are not able to join us at present, it was suggested we try and meet in the presbytery after Mass, as long as meetings of up to six are still permitted. Tom will confirm.
