Peace Service 2020: Fr. Matthias has confirmed that this is booked for 1st January at 7.30 pm. We will await information from Pax Christi on the theme and suggested service.

Any Other business:

Merton Homelessness and Rough Sleeping Strategy 2020-2023; Merton is currently developing a strategy and is consulting faith organisations and voluntary sector providers. Merton are obliged to provide a shelter when the temperature falls below a certain level. Charities are endeavouring to find out where this shelter is.

Extraordinary Month of Mission – Missio are encouraging us to follow Pope Francis' calls to renew our missionary commitment during October, the month of prayer and action. Year of the Word: Teresa has written up the Year of the Word for Talkabout and will write this issue about the canonisation of Cardinal Newman. We should look for the Biblical Dimension of Justice and Peace.
